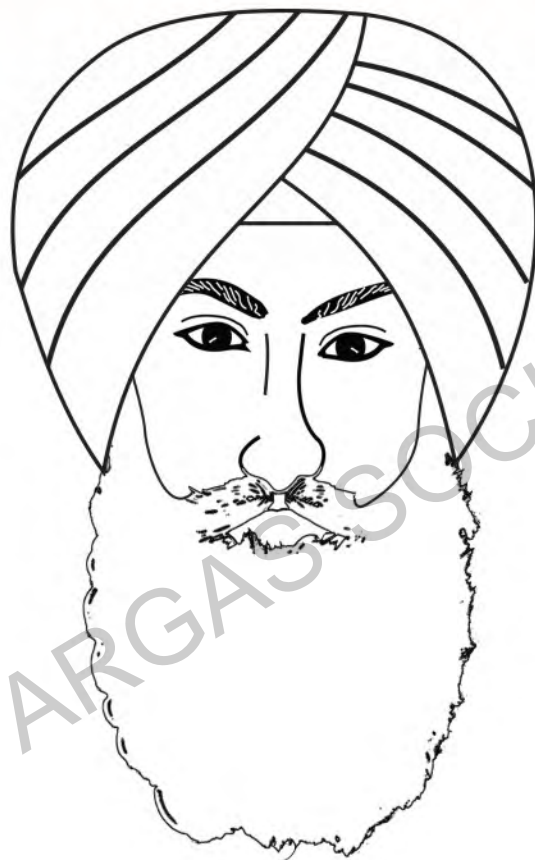

The Sikh Emblem consists of :

1. **Khandaa** (double edged sword) :

A potent metaphor of divine knowledge. Its sharp edges cleave truth from falsehood.

2. **Two swords** :

One of *Miri* - The Symbol of sovereignty.

Other of *Piri* - The Symbol of spirituality.

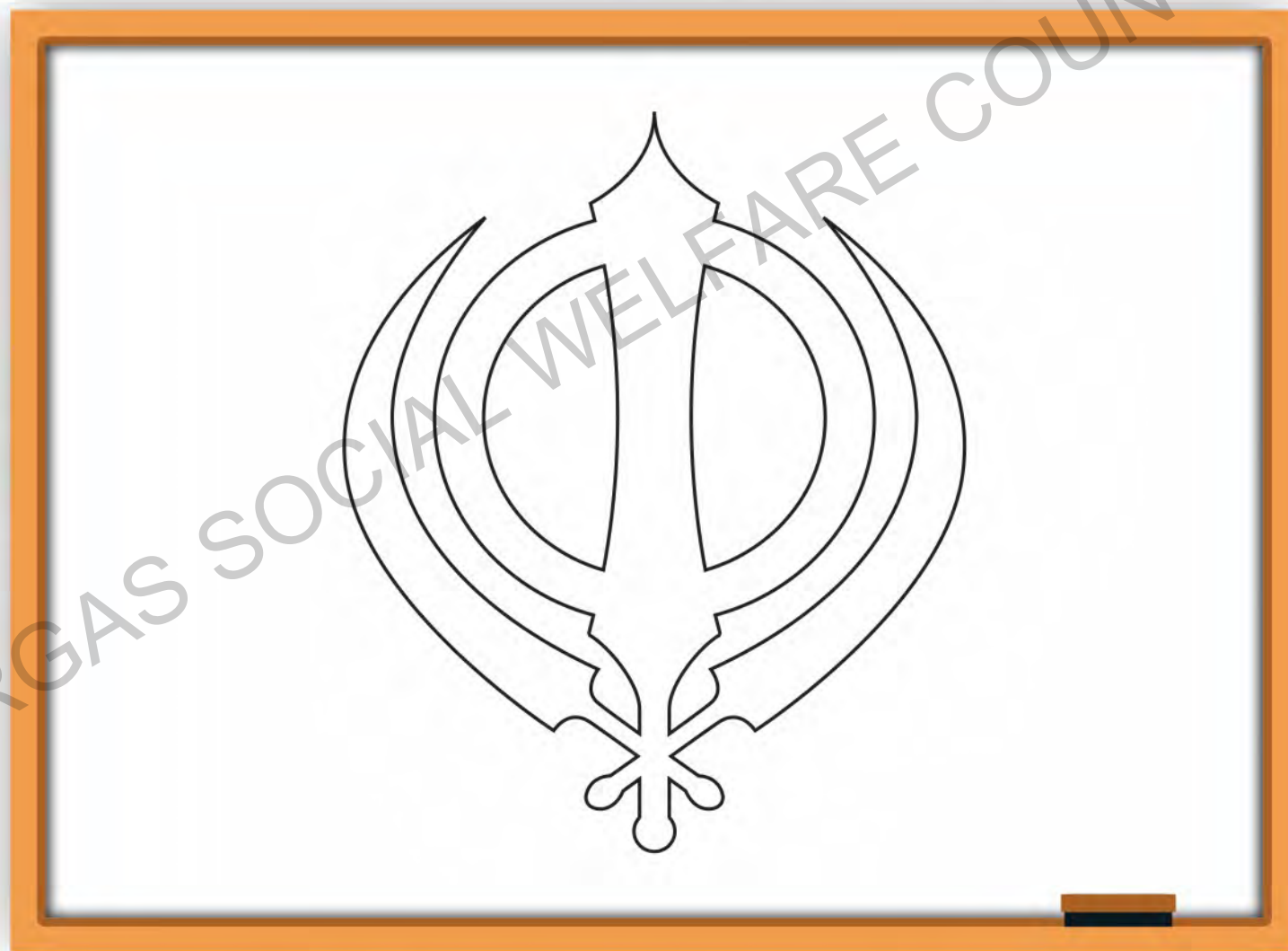
3. **Chakkar** (a figure without beginning or end) :

It signifies the omnipresence and command of infinite God.

The Sikh Emblem is popularly known as *Khandaa* - The name derived from central part of the logo.

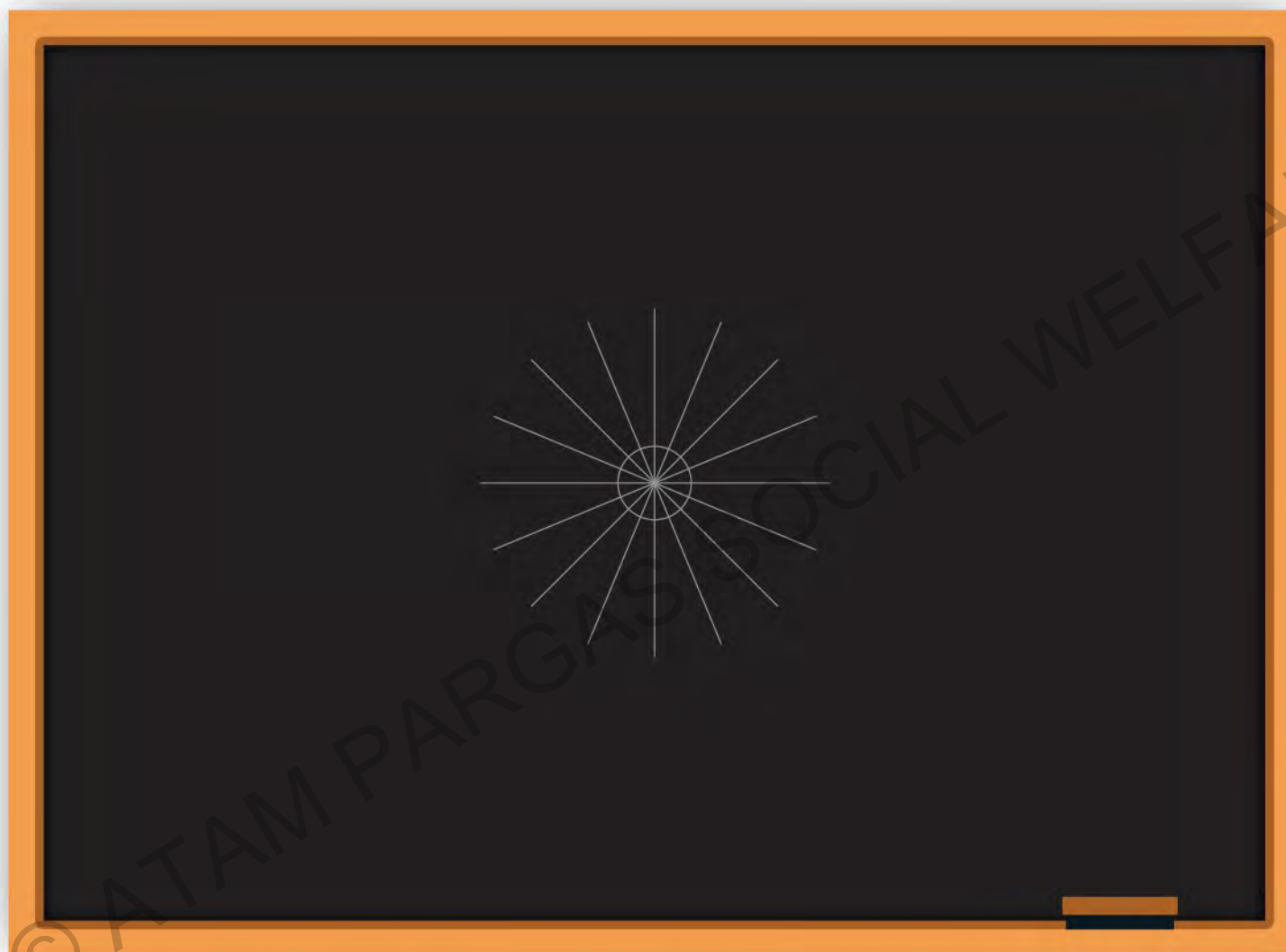
